Free School Meals & Pupil Premium

You can claim free school meals for your child if the child is in full-time education, you are responsible for the child, **and** you are getting one of the following benefits:

- Income Support
- Income based Job Seekers Allowance
- Income Related Employment and Support Allowance
- Guaranteed Pension Credit
- Child Tax Credit with an annual income each year of less than £16,190 (as assessed by Tax Credits)
- Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999

If you receive Child Tax Credit **and** Working Tax Credit, your child will not qualify for free school meals.

If your application for free school meals is accepted, the school will receive Pupil Premium Funding. Pupil Premium is additional funding that the school receives to support children whose parents are on benefits and are entitled to free school meals. Parents can use £50.00 of this money to pay towards school visits or uniform.

Under the Universal Infant Free School Meals Offer all pupils from Reception (FS2) to Year 2 are entitled to free school meals. However, you will only be able to access the Pupil Premium Funding if you are in receipt of the above benefits and complete the Free School Meals application form.

Just to remind you that Breakfast Club runs from **8.00am until 8.50am**. Food is served until **8.30am**. Please do not send your child before 8.00am as we cannot guarantee that there will be a member of staff available to let them in. Breakfast club is £1.00 per day.
