

Consequences:

Verbal Warning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> No action
2 nd Warning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> KS1: 5 minutes time out KS2: 10 minutes time out
3 rd Warning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Name given to teacher at the end of lunchtime. Next step on the class behaviour chart
4 th Warning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sent inside to a member of the Senior Leadership Team. Loss of playtime Red on the class behaviour chart Mrs Kinnaird to contact parents
5 th Warning	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Sent to Miss Beckett Straight to red on the class behaviour chart Parents/Carers invited in to discuss lunchtime behaviour

During time out the children will need to sit in the quiet area but they must be supervised by an adult.

Any act of violence or aggression towards staff or children will be an automatic red on the class behaviour chart and the child will be sent to a member of the Senior Leadership Team.
